5. Termination, Transportation, and General

- a. Agri-Service may terminate this Agreement at any time upon first giving customer five (5) days' notice of termination and Customer has no more than thirty (30) days after the notice of termination to remove Customer's Equipment from Agri-Service's facility. Customer may terminate this Agreement on giving Agri-Service five (5) business days' notice of termination and removing Customer's Equipment from Agri-Service's facility and Customer has no more than thirty (30) days after the notice of termination to remove equipment from Agri-Service's facility. Customer shall be responsible for arranging for and paying all costs for transportation for moving Customer's Equipment from Agri-Service's facility to Customer's preferred destination unless otherwise agreed upon or provided in the terms and conditions of sale or service.
- **b.** Any notice required or convenient to be given under this Agreement shall be in writing. Notices shall be effectively given if transmitted electronically, sent by United States first-class mail, postage prepaid, or addressed to the parties as follows:
